MEMBERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

Our Mission: To encourage, educate, share and nurture interest in sustainable living by creating a vibrant community farm within an urban environment.

As a condition of membership, members are asked to abide by the following Code of Conduct.

Respect for other individuals

- Members will respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person (child or adult), regardless of their abilities, gender, sexuality, religion or cultural background.
- Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated. This includes:
 - Swearing or yelling
 - Bullying
 - Sexually suggestive comments/jokes
 - o Racist comments/jokes
 - Using derogatory language or making insensitive comments
 - o Harassing, humiliating or intimidating others
 - o Violent or aggressive behaviour

Repeated upheld complaints may result in cancellation of membership.

General Farm Operations

- Whilst acknowledging members are also volunteers, the Farm cannot run successfully
 without input from all members. Therefore there is an expectation that all members will
 spend some time helping with the maintenance of communal areas of the Farm either on an
 ad hoc basis or by participating in working bees.
- All garden tools and equipment should be used only for the job they are designed for, and returned clean and in good condition. Please let the Committee know if tools have been damaged.
- The use of harmful chemicals in the garden is not permitted. Instead, natural environmental and biological controls are the preferred methods used to combat pests and diseases.
- Gardeners should not knowingly introduce weedy, prohibited or diseased plants to the garden.
- All activities in the garden must be conducted in a safe manner and in daylight hours.
- Beelarong Community Farm aims to be accessible to all people. Pathways and access routes should be kept clear to ensure there are no physical barriers to participation.
- Garden allotments should be kept free of weeds.
- Produce should be harvested in a timely manner. Not harvesting regularly increases the risk
 of disease and also increases the temptation for others to help themselves to farm produce
 rather than letting it go to waste.
